Description and uses

299 Paint Stripper is a solvent based, heavy bodied paint remover recommended for removal of most types of paints and lacquers.

299 Paint Stripper has the following features:

- Fast acting and non-caustic.
- Non-staining.
- Harmless to timber and metal surfaces.

Typical areas of application are:

- Light industrial environments.
- Metal fabrication and associated industries.
- Restoration work.

Application

Apply a heavy film of 299 Paint Stripper to the surface by brush. Allow paint to wrinkle, then scrape off with a paint scraper or hose down with a high pressure water jet. Repeat above until all paint is removed. Surfaces should then be washed down with wax and grease remover prior to painting.

Safety Instructions

Caution: 299 Paint Stripper contains dichloromethane, container may pressurize on storage.

Flammability: Not flammable.

Personal Protection: Avoid contact with skin or eyes, wear suitable clothing such as impervious overalls, PVC or neoprene gloves, and safety goggles. Wear an air-fed mask or, for short periods of work, a combination of charcoal filter and particulate filter is recommended.

Engineering controls: Ensure ventilation is adequate. Local exhaust or mechanical ventilation may be required.
